TO: Hofstra University Payroll Office:

Consistent with the relevant provisions of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement (Article 14), I hereby authorize you to deduct my annual AAUP dues from my salary. This authorization shall remain in effect unless terminated by me upon written notice of withdrawal or by termination of my employment. I understand that the dues rate is .75% of base salary up to a maximum of \$653 for the 2009/2010 academic year and will increase by the increase in national dues in subsequent years. If I am an entrant*, I understand that my National AAUP dues will be reduced by \$95.00 for the 2009/2010 academic year and by one-half the national AAUP dues in the three subsequent years. Joint ** members shall receive the same deduction indefinitely. Deductions for 2009/2010 dues will be made in equal installments each pay period through August 31, 2009.
